Soo Hill MEAP Scores - Fall 2005

Students received a score of 1, 2, 3 or 4 in each category. A 1 is the highest score and a 4 is the lowest. All students who receive a 1 or a 2 on a test are said to be proficient in that subject area. Soo Hill's percentage of students who scored proficient (SH) are compared to the Escanaba Area Public Schools (District) and the State of Michigan (State) percentages of students who scored proficient in each category.
